

NOTICE TO ALL CREWS

No Engineer or Crew Member at any time shall apply the brakes to any Locomotive or Train and then apply the throttle to increase speed and hold the train back, in order to make it appear that the Locomotive is working harder, thus increasing the amount of exhaust (Smoke) for any reason.

No Engineer or Crew Member at any time shall apply the brakes to any Locomotive or Train and then apply the throttle to increase speed and drag the train, thus causing the wheels on any car(s) to stop and slide along the rails, causing sparks.

All Train Crew members are to exercise care when operating any train to take care to operate the train in a safe and efficient manner, as to not cause any damage to the Locomotive or Rolling Stock.
