## Museum Volunteers and Employees

While performing their jobs, or any service on museum property. All Museum volunteers and/or employees are expected to work in accordance with the following:

The "CODE OF SAFE PRACTICES" or "INJURY AND ILLNESS PREVENTION PROGRAM" shall be used as the general safety manual for all personnel.

A copy of this manual is posted in the Operations Office.

It is the Museum's policy to operate the Western Pacific Railroad Museum in a safe and efficient manner.

A copy of the Volunteers and Employees warning notice containing a listing for health hazards is posted in the Operations Office, and in work areas where the health hazards are associated.

In addition, the warning notice must be posted on all bulletin boards.

It is the Museum's policy to comply with all applicable hazardous materials laws and regulations, and minimize or, when possible, eliminate its use of hazardous materials. When the use of hazardous materials is unavoidable because of operating requirements, the Museum assures that volunteers and employees receive the information they need to safely handle them, and that procedures and safeguards are implemented to protect volunteers and employees from any unnecessary exposure or risks.
