## **To All Train and Engine Crews**

Effective immediately, the following instructions will apply:

- 1. The UP Ramp Track is <u>not</u> to be used for storage of FRRS equipment, particularly that portion of the track which extends back into the UP yard. It is permissible to use the portion of this track which is inside our fence as a temporary spot for equipment during switching, but the track **must** be left clear when switching is completed.
- Exceptions to this requirement will be considered on a case-by-case basis, such as Museum special events. It may be necessary to contact the UP prior to placing equipment on this track, and, in all cases, prior approval to use this track must be obtained from the FRRS Yardmaster, Operations Superintendent, or the Museum Executive Director.
