NOTICE TO ALL CREWS

This bulletin remains in effect until cancelled or superceded.

While inspecting Locomotives during the start up procedures and/or during normal operation, anytime a locomotive(s) is being operated by any of the operating department crews or R.A.L. Engineers, Should the engine lubricating oil be at the LOW mark, or become BELOW the LOW mark, the locomotive shall be taken out of service.

A notice shall be placed on the bulletin board (white board) of the condition of the locomotive(s) and notification shall be made to the Chief Mechanical Office in writing, by means of the locomotive inspection sheet, and placed into his mailbox.

The locomotive(s) should not be returned to service by operating department crews or R.A.L. Engineers until the locomotive(s) are serviced and released for service by the mechanical staff.
