SUBJECT: Archives Name, Logo and Letterhead

In following the definitions commonly used for the words Archives and Library one finds that an Archives is collections of materials, ie; the Virgil Staff Collection, and a Library is that which houses and cares for those collections.

For that reason I propose that the name associated with the archives department be formally adopted, recognized and referred to by the Feather River Rail Society as the Arthur Walter Keddie Railroad Library.

From the Oxford Dictionaries:

archive

noun (usually **archives**)

- a collection of historical documents or records providing information about a place, institution, or group of people: *[as modifier]: a section of archive film*
- the place where historical documents or records are kept: *they were allowed to study in the archives*
- a complete record of the data in part or all of a computer system, stored on an infrequently used medium.

- place or store (something) in an archive.


library

noun (plural **libraries**)



- a collection of books and periodicals held in a library: *the Institute houses an outstanding library of 35,000 volumes on the fine arts*
