Convention planning continues. Scott McAllister and I are having a big meeting Sunday, April 14 to review many items and meet with some of our presenters. The banquet and venue seem to be finalized and in place. I am hoping to hear back on a speaker by Sunday.

It looks like we may be one show short, but we are looking for someone to fill that slot.

Registration has been slow. We currently have maybe 50 people for the Convention and 38 for the Banquet. The R Street Ramble and Photo Clinic have about 4-5 people each. The issue of the Train Sheet currently in the mail has a registration form and Tom Carter has updated the website with all options now, including the special R Street tour and Photo Clinic with Ken Rattenne.
