### Funding

The Spring Fundraising Mailer went out and we have been receiving returns over the last few days. No count yet, but we have received several donations via PayPal.

### Archives

As part of research for my convention show on the Deep Creek Railroad, I performed a “test run” using new tracking documents and procedures for interdepartmental archive access being developed by Mike Mucklin. In addition, with Mike’s permission, I am working with some of the archive materials to assist in a future issue on the Indian Valley Railroad.

With input from Gail McClure and Mike Mucklin on pricing and presentation, we will hopefully be offering copies of archive images for sale at the Convention. I am also hoping to take pre-orders for the 2016 Calendar, which I already have 80% laid out.

### Volunteer Hours and Miles
