## WP Headlights from the 1940's

In mid-2021, I started a project that would post a complete set of the WP's employee magazine, *The HEADLIGHT*, from the 1940's on our website. This is not to be confused with the FRRS publication, THE WESTERN PACIFIC *Headlight*. I was able to collect scanned PDF files of all the 1940s issues, except November 1942.

As reported in the H/A report last month, Kerry Cochran and I visited the CSRM Library in Sacramento on 10/4/22. After the visit, I followed up with Chris Rockwell of CSRM to inquire if they had a copy of the November 1942 issue. He was able to find one and scanned it for us. I have used it to complete our collection.

## Mailtrain

We continue to have society members and the public signup on our "*WPRM News*" email distribution list on Mailtrain. We now have 385 active email addresses on the list. Last month we had 371, so we had a net increase of 14 subscribers this month. One person reported a Mailtrain email as spam to Yahoo, so I unsubscribed the person. It is unfortunate the person reported it as spam to their email provider rather than use the unsubscribe link in the email. We run the risk of email providers blacklisting us if they get reports of spam from our server. We had a problem with att.net / sbcglobal.net / pacbell.net addresses all marking our email as spam very early this year. I have a detailed report in my February 2022 Webmaster report to the board about it.

## YouTube Handle

YouTube is introducing handles to make it easier for members of the community to find and connect with each other. Our handle will be unique to our channel and will be how people mention us in comments, community posts, and more. My first choice was WPLives, but it was not available. My second choice was FRRS, which also was not available. The handle for our YouTube channel will be @WPRM.
