Dear Mr. Evans:

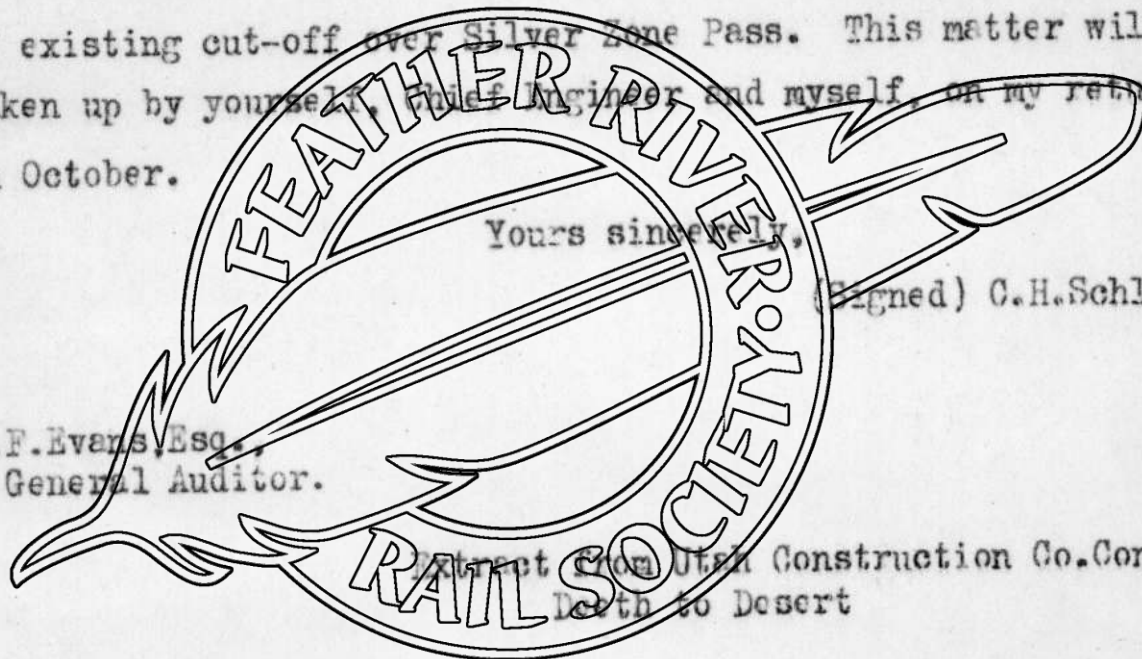
Referring to verbal instructions given to yourself and Mr. Wyche, yesterday:

The A.F.E. covering entire work of completing Arnold's Loop, is to be made up without reference to any credit growing out of any future determined abandonment of a portion of existing cut-off over Silver Zone Pass. This matter will be taken up by yourself, Chief Engineer and myself, on my return in October.
