## Political Contributions

### Statement of Policy

It is FRRS's policy to make no contribution of corporate funds in connection with any ballot measures, political parties, or other organizations.

It is FRRS's policy that neither corporate nor any other funds will be used for any political contribution purposes that support any candidates seeking state and local office

### Overall Accountability

The Board of Directors is responsible for issuing, updating, and monitoring compliance with this policy.

### Scope

This policy applies to the entire FRRS.

### Definitions *(refer also to "Definitions" section of the Corporate Policy Manual)*

A **political contribution** includes the donation or loan of any museum funds on behalf of, a political campaign or committee. A political contribution also includes the expenditure of museum funds or the use of museum labor, property, or equipment for the purpose of supporting or opposing a political campaign or committee.

A **Ballot measures** include propositions which have qualified to appear on any state or local ballot, or which are proposed for qualification for the ballot through the initiative or referendum process.

**Political parties** include the official national, state, and local committees formed by the Democratic . Party, Republican Party, or Independent Party.
