WELCOME to the 2024 Western Pacific Railroad Historic Convention, hosted by the Feather Falls Casino and Resort in Oroville, California. Produced by the FEATHER RIVER RAIL SOCIETY.

Oroville, California was always a major location on the Western Pacific. Set at the foot of the long climb into the Feather River Canyon, Oroville and Portola were the end points of WP's Third Subdidivision, traversing the railroad's namesake route and arguably the most famous section of the WP. It was also a major terminal for the Sacramento Northern, which operated a branch into the city. Severed by flooding west of town in 1937, the SN line would operate as an isolated feeder to the WP until 1957 and was electrified until 1954. Today the Union Pacific and BNSF still operate the fabled Feather River Canyon Route, keeping the WP heritage alive!


